Strum Consulting was retained by the insurer of a home heating oil company to respond to the scene of an overturned fuel oil delivery vehicle, provide direction with regards to emergency containment of released petroleum fluids, and oversee all necessary environmental site assessments and remediation associated with the incident which consisted of the loss of approximately 1,600 L of diesel fuel oil impacting the provincial road parcel and an adjacent privately owned property.

Strum coordinated and supervised all aspects of remediation and Environmental Site Assessment (ESA) activities, ensuring compliance with provincial regulations. A Qualitative Risk Assessment (QRA) was completed to assess potential risks to people, property, and the environment associated with residual petroleum hydrocarbon contamination left to remain below the structural footprint of the provincial road parcel. Regulatory compliance was achieved through the development and the implementation of a Risk Management Plan (RMP).
